Working on getting presenters, including Australian Packaging Covenant, City of Casey, presentation from one of the projects below.</p> <p>JM - Projects: MWRRG project on community engagement programs (with Articulus Communications), SV project on community trust and perceptions (with CSIRO).</p> <p>TOH – Will forward any invitations from MWRRG to the wider CRG (he’s on their mailing list).</p> <p>KS – proposed Nial Finnegan as guest for 2nd half of year to update on MAC review.</p>		
<p>6</p>	<p>SUEZ Operations Update</p> <p>KS – NH leaving next week, still recruiting replacement. JJ will be acting in role on part time basis (3-4 days/wk), JB will be acting in JJ’s absence. JB and JJ both up-to-speed re handover.</p> <p>KS – MG leaving SUEZ to join Transpacific, staying on until Feb 24. SUEZ in process of recruiting replacement.</p> <p>MG – Currently recruiting additional compliance officer for site.</p> <p>MG – Extensive landfill gas bore installation over next 2-3 months. Some new bores, some replacements of old/damaged bores.</p> <p>MG – Cell construction progressing well. Capping works ongoing.</p> <p>MG – SUEZ has had a number of break-ins in last month, including theft of ute from SITA-ResourceCo. Security increased.</p> <p>MG – No further progress on 3am opening since last meeting, will have to submit application to council. KS advises SUEZ still intends to pursue this. KS advises 3am start granted at Taylors Road Landfill, but preferable to open early at Hallam Road Landfill as this is where operations/equipment is. General discussion about noise as major issue, and how to mitigate this noise.</p> <p>MG – Sunday closures discussed with MWRRG and councils, data provided showing reduced volumes. MWRRG supportive of closures, councils prefer to hold SUEZ to current contract. Discussion expected in February.</p> <p>TOH – requested update on entrance/exit at SITA-ResourceCo. SUEZ advises increase in volumes since September, no issues/incidents.</p> <p>HG – Requested update on recent grass fire. No impact on SUEZ land or operations. SUEZ provided front end loader to assist CFA with access to fire by moving logs. JB outlined SUEZ’s emergency response plan - fight fire as long as possible, evacuate if situation becomes dangerous. General discussion around causes and management of fires/hot loads in collection vehicles.</p>
