All you have to do is **register**. You can do it now by filling in this form, and faxing it to Close the Loop on **(03) 9930 8695**.

Within a matter of days, you will receive a starter kit, consisting of a collection box, with 16 pre-labeled liners, ties and instructions. After the box is assembled we suggest you **place the spare liners and ties in the bottom of the Collection Box** before inserting the first bin liners.

That way, as soon as the box is full, and you have removed the full liner, you can **immediately** insert the next liners.
